

**Please note:** Initial iPhone setup must be done using a wireless internet connection and cannot be established while using WiFi.

Steps are compatible with 3G and 4.0.

To set up POP, do the following:

1. Tap **Settings**.



2. Tap **Mail, Contacts, Calendars**.
3. Tap **Add Account**.
4. Tap **Other**.
5. Tap **Add Mail Account**.
6. Enter the following information in the spaces provided:
  - Name—Enter your first and last name. This is the name that will appear in the **From** field of messages you send.
  - Address—Enter your entire email address (e.g., myname@mydomain.com).
  - Password—Enter the password for your email account.
  - Description—Enter a descriptive name for the account (e.g., Work Account). This description will be visible only to you.
7. Tap the **Save** button.
8. Tap the **POP** button.
9. Under both the **Incoming Mail Server** and **Outgoing Mail Server** sections, enter the following information:
  - Host Name—Enter the secure server name:  
**secure.emailsrvr.com**
  - User Name—Enter your entire email address (e.g., myname@mydomain.com).

- Password—Enter the password for your email account.
